

My J Drive Quick Setup Guide


Download and run the installer from <http://www.myjdrive.com>.




Click Next.




Accept the license agreement and click Next.



Leave the default install location and click Next.




Click Install.



Wait for the install to finish.




When install completes, hit Finish.



You will be prompted to restart. You need to restart in order for the new network drive to function. Click Yes.




After reboot the program will automatically start and the first time setup wizard will appear. Click Next.




For the domain, enter myjdrive. Username and password are unique to your account and should have been provided. Enter those and click Next.


This next screen will not appear on the first computer you add to a J-Drive account. If this is the first computer you are connecting to J-Drive, skip this screen.




If you are reinstalling the software on a computer that had it before, move the radio button to replace and select the computer on the pulldown menu. If this is a new install on a computer not listed, leave the radio button on Create. Click Next.




This screen is for setting up an automatic backup to the new cloud account for this computer you are installing on. It is optional and you can set it up at a later time. For now, set the time to Manual Only then click Next.




Now is when you will assign the new drive letter. The Default is J, which is what we want to set up. However, if your computer is already using the letter J for a different drive, the next available drive letter will be selected here. The default cache size of 5GB is fine. Click Next.



Adding a Sync folder is another optional feature. What this will allow you to do is select a local folder on your computer that will Sync with a folder on your new J drive. Since this is optional, we won't go through the setup of it here. Just click Next.




The setup wizard is now complete. Click Finish.



The main application window will be open. You can close that now too.



You should now see this icon in your system tray. This means the J drive is running and accessible.



Looking at My Computer you should now see a new J network drive.
